TAYplan, the Strategic Development Planning Authority that covers the local authority areas of Angus, Dundee City, North Fife and Perth & Kinross has prepared a Proposed Strategic Development Plan.

The Proposed Plan is a key stage in the preparation of a Strategic Development Plan for the area and is intended to replace the existing Structure Plans within the TAYplan area. The Plan sets the long term spatial landuse strategy, vision and the policies and proposals to deliver this. The Plan sets out where development should and should not go and the infrastructure required to deliver the vision.
